All children have the right to protection, regardless of age, gender, race, culture or disability, thus ensuring a secured and stable environment. They have the right to be safe in school and the school follows a specific child protection policy. We are committed to creating and maintaining an environment that discourages bullying and deal constructively with any instances that may occur following the whole school anti-bullying policy. We aim to promote an open and trustworthy ethos ensuring each child's right to privacy, dignity, independence and individuality. Each child is treated equally, and we encourage them to learn how to exercise some freedom responsibly. This fosters the behaviour traits of respect, kindness, honesty, care, cooperation, and develops strong interpersonal relationships. We follow the whole school behavior approach for learning policy, which is designed to support the way in which all members of the school live and work together. Children's emails, letters, phone calls, both incoming and outgoing, are not censored, and the personal cupboard space is totally private. At Delhi Public School, Durgapur, we take pride in the emotional and mental wellbeing of the children in our care as a part of the complete development of each boarder. It's important for the students to share their worries and feelings with us and their angel teachers.

The Hostel team is always there to listen to children after a busy day, helping to promote a strong and healthy mental wellbeing so they will be able to:

We hope to create a family atmosphere so that each child feels the hostel to be an extension of home. We strongly believe that the children should be the center of the Hostel running process.

## Admission Rules

**Admission Policy:** The child has to first follow the admission process of the school and then can opt for Hostel Facility.

**Supporting Documents** other than school admission procedure: Parent's Request Letter to enroll in hostel, documents of local guardian with parents' authorization letter.

**E-MAIL:** Parents can send the application on a plain paper with documents via email to [info@dpsdurgapur.com](mailto:info@dpsdurgapur.com). If there is any issue that needs further discussion, such an issue will be taken care by the academic coordinators.



### Form for withdrawal of students from hostel

In case of any reason, if a student after enrolment in the hostel, wishes to withdraw, then only hostel caution money will be refunded, which is subject to clearance of all dues payable. In no circumstances, any dues payable to the hostel will be adjusted against the hostel caution money. A written notice of withdrawal must be given one month (clear) in advance, or one month's hostel fees must be in lieu thereof.







## MEALS IN A DAY

A well-balanced nutritious diet (4 times a day) is served in clean and hygienic dining hall. Filtered cold and warm water (during winters) is available. Special meals are provided on special occasions.

Parents are to notify the warden if their child is allergic to any food being served at the hostel. This will help the wardens to make alternate arrangements and keep a check on the child's food to avoid any allergic reactions or sickness.

## MEDICAL FACILITY

In case a child is down with contagious infection, parents are requested to keep them at home to avoid spreading of the infection to the other students. Parents need to inform the school office regarding the absence, followed by a letter and necessary medical documents when the child re-joins school.

Delhi Public School has a fully equipped Infirmary which is looked after by a qualified nurse. Medical check-ups of students are regularly carried out and a record is maintained. If the doctor is of the opinion that a child needs special medical attention, the parents are informed of the same.



## BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

Birthday Celebration will be allowed only on Parent's request within a limited budget and arrangements by parents in the hostel premises under the strict supervision of the wardens. Students are allowed to talk on a video call with the family.

## CAREER INFORMATION, EDUCATION AND GUIDANCE

These sessions are conducted by experienced and dedicated professionals who inform, educate and guide students about the opportunities and challenges that await them upon completion of their schooling. These talks by eminent career counsellors place our students at the forefront of innovation and advancement and connect them to ever-widening networks of growth and learning.

Career counselling sessions by representatives of prestigious Universities of the United States, United Kingdom, Canada, Australia and Singapore regularly visit the school to apprise the students regarding the courses offered, application method, sponsorships available and the general quality of life in these institutions and the countries they belong to.



## SPORTS FACILITIES

'All work and no play, makes Jack a dull boy' – this goes without saying and the same applies to school kids. They cannot always engage in studies and must have the space of balancing and dividing time to study, play and spend time in recreational activities.

**For better opportunities, students can avail –**

- Air-conditioned fitness gymnasium with trained and efficient experts
- Sports ground with floodlights and special turf
- Coaches for badminton, Table Tennis, Basketball, Cricket, Football, Karate, Chess and Yoga
- Various other games or sports events that will be introduced with time.
- All weather swimming pool (coming soon).







**In-Campus Separate Hostels for Boys and Girls:** Located in-campus, the school offers separate hostel facilities for boys and girls, and it is open for students from Classes V to XII.



**Accommodation:** Well-furnished dormitories have separate bed, study table and wardrobe for each student. Each floor has a toilet block with multiple toilets and bathrooms. AC hostel coming soon.

**Tuition and Remedial Classes:** The hostellers are provided with tuition classes on a regular basis by highly experienced teachers. Remedial sessions in various subjects are organised as per requirement. Special preparations are arranged for NEET/IIT/JEE students.



**Entertainment & Outings:** Popular movies and important sport events are shown on the big screen in the Audio-Visual Hall. Once in a month outing to the city and nearby areas by school buses happen under the supervision of the Wardens.



# HOSTEL FACILITIES



**Sick Bay:** The infirmary is run under the guidance of qualified nurse. The school has tie-up with few prominent hospitals of the city for emergency treatment.

**Art, Dance & Music:** Special classes are held regularly for boarders to pursue their passion for art, music and dance under the supervision of expert teachers.



**Quest for Excellence:** The air-conditioned library (Resource Centre) has an impressive collection of books, reference books and encyclopedia. It also offers a large pool of audio and video resources. Books specific to competitive exams are there to help students crack National and State level competitive exams.



**Games, Common Room and Internet:** Well-equipped Gymnasium, facilities for Football, Cricket, Basketball, Badminton, Table Tennis, Carrom, Pool and Chess are available to the students. The common rooms have TV and PCs with Internet connection.



**Security & Power Back Up:** 24-hr vigilance by Wardens, Security Guards & support staff. CCTV cameras at strategic locations. Strict procedure for issuing Out Passes and allowing visitors to the hostel. We have 24\*7 generator back-up.

# STUDENT BEHAVIOR

## STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO:

Be honest during tests, examinations and submissions of assignments

Be courteous and polite to every member of the DPS Family

Participate fully in classroom and other activities

Treat with care and respect school property and the property of fellow students\*

Have healthy eating and sleeping habits

Greet all staff

Keep the campus clean; use litter bins

Switch off lights, fans when not required

Turn off taps after use

*\*Any damage to school property will be made good by the student and deducted from his pocket money.*

## GENTLE GROOMING

- 1 Early to bed and early to rise' is very much practiced in the hostel. All the students will be in and out of their beds as per the hostel schedule.
- 2 Morning activities are compulsory except if excused on medical ground.
- 3 A high level of personal hygiene must always be maintained.
- 4 Cleanliness is next to Godliness'. Keeping this in mind the students will maintain their cupboard and cubicle neat and tidy.
- 5 Students must follow the dress code strictly as per the occasion/ timings. Funky hairdos (spikes/streaks) are not allowed.
- 6 Girls/Boys will dress decently at all given times.
- 7 Girls/Boys are not allowed to wear sleeveless shirts or shorts in the refectory / dining hall.
- 8 Shorts can be worn by the students only during games and in their respective hostel rooms.
- 9 The student will inform the Hostel Warden if any maintenance work has to be done in their room.
- 10 The hostel building is out of bound during school hours. The students will sleep in night wear only.
- 11 Before sleeping students should be prepared for the next day in terms of uniform, polishing shoes and completing home assignment.
- 12 **Bullying or ragging in any form (verbal, physical and emotional) is not accepted.**
- 13 If any student damages the school property, the cost will be recovered from the imprest account.
- 14 School personnel can check student's belongings if required at any time.
- 15 TV and computer usage is limited and will be allowed only as per the schedule.

## GENERAL RULES

1. Boarders are not allowed to keep valuables, jewellery and any other articles, which are not approved by the school authorities. Students are not permitted to keep any money or cash with them during their stay in the Hostel.
2. Room furniture, electric fittings, etc. are required to be maintained by the inmates in good condition. At the time of allotment of room and leaving the hostel for the vacation, every student must take-over and hand-over, respectively, the hostel property carefully.
3. Cupboards will be arranged neatly. Surprise checks will be made by the Hostel warden. Any extra item, other than those specified in the hostel kit will be confiscated.
4. Students must NOT keep with them laptop, mobile, IPod, CD-players, i-pods, razors, blades, heaters, kettles, irons, immersion rod..
5. Students must NOT bring to the boarding drugs of any type, tobacco in any form or alcohol. Any student found with such items will be asked to be withdrawn from the school immediately.
6. Boarders must remain, and study in their respective rooms/dorms or class rooms during study time as directed by the authority.
7. Boarders must take part in all the educational activities arranged by the school or hostel.
8. Any willful damage to or theft of school property or other's property will be regarded as a breach of School/Hostel rules and the student would be fined by the School Authorities.
9. The Campus Administrator / Hostel Wardens/ or any other Officials of the School along with Security Guards may at their discretion inspect /check any room or student's belongings in the presence of the students living there in any time of the day or night.
10. Ragging and bullying of any kind is severely punishable and may lead to expulsion from the school. As such, students are advised not to indulge in any such activity. No one is permitted to subject any other student to any kind of ill-treatment, either physical or mental.
11. Students are not permitted to possess any sordid reading/viewing material.
12. Any child involved in any immoral act is liable to be expelled without warning, and there will be no reconsideration whatsoever. There will be no refund of fee in such cases. Furthermore, Principal or the disciplinary committee may not assign any reason for doing so.
13. No student is permitted to buy, sell or exchange goods or lend or borrow money from each other or from the staff. Nor are they allowed to do so with any outsider especially when they go for outings from the school.
14. **The change of status from boarder to day scholar will not be entertained in the mid-session.**
15. All students must report on the given date after the vacation/leave etc., In case of any emergency, written request giving detailed reasons, should be provided by the parents to the Principal, and a written permission must be obtained to condone the delay in arrival.
16. Any application for attending marriages, functions or any other events during the school term will not be entertained, unless it pertains to the parents or siblings. Written permission for the same must be obtained well in advance.
17. Laundry is given on the days notified by the competent authority. It will be washed, pressed and returned to the Boarders as approved by the hostel council. In case of loss or damage, the Boarders must inform the laundry personnel immediately. The complaint could also be entered in the complaint book provided in the hostel.
18. Rules may be changed without prior information to the parents and students. Parents/guardians seeking admission for their ward should carefully read the rules and regulations of the school, as well as hostel. Lack of knowledge of rules and regulations can't be accepted as an excuse.
19. Parents are requested to send leave application with supporting documents to [hostel.leaveapplication@dpsdurgapur.net](mailto:hostel.leaveapplication@dpsdurgapur.net) in the cases of:
  - Medical Necessity
  - Special Occasion
  - Extreme Emergency
20. Students of Classes 11 &12 only, are allowed to keep the phones with themselves for two hours for study purpose. They must ensure that the time is not wasted in playing games/texting or watching sordid content.



# RULES FOR HOSTELLERS

- 1 Boarders must remain, and study in their respective rooms/dorms or class rooms during study time as directed by the competent authority.
- 2 The hostellers will remain in their respective rooms after the night roll-call for self-study. The study hour supervision will be done on their respective floors by respective wardens.
- 3 Hostellers will follow the daily routine of the hostel and school, unless exempted on medical grounds or recommended by hostel warden.
- 4 The lights-off time will be notified later on and the students are expected to abide by the rule.
- 5 Boarders are expected to behave well in public, and represent their school with pride.
- 6 During study hours, all students must devote their time to academic preparation in the study room. Silence is mandatory.
- 7 Students must work independently, unless they are allowed for a group study session with in full knowledge of house brother/sister. Group study sessions will happen in common areas and not in individual rooms.
- 8 Students are expected to utilize the time fruitfully by spending the allotted time in studying. They must not waste this time in room or taking shower.
- 9 Taps in bathroom/toilets must be closed, whenever they are not in use. Fans and lights must be switched off whenever the students leave their rooms. They must switch off all lights, when they go to bed. In case it is noticed that the fans/lights are switched-on in the bolted room, a penalty will be imposed for wasting the precious energy.
- 10 Cleanliness and Hygiene:- All students are expected to maintain a high standard of personal hygiene. Daily bath and personal cleanliness is essential. Wearing fresh socks and underclothing every day is must. Students are to tidy up their own rooms, beds and cupboards.
- 11 The student shall take prior permission of the Warden /Campus Administrator for celebrating any festivals and birthdays. Birthday celebration should be done at a common place, there should not be any kind of discomfort to other students. No outside guest or interference of any kind will be allowed.
- 12 Any boarder falling sick, will report to the House Warden, who will record the action taken, in the sick register. It should be signed both by the student and Warden.
- 13 Hostellers will not be allowed to keep and take medicines/tonics without the knowledge of the Hostel Warden.
- 14 Physical exercise, meditation, sports, games, yoga and other relaxation techniques are compulsory for all boarders, unless exempted by the competent authority. Separate schedule may be fixed for boys and girls, depending upon their class.
- 15 Students will be punished for scribbling any graffiti on the walls/furniture, using foul language, indulging in unruly behavior in the corridors, or for any other form of vandalism.
- 16 They are not allowed to wear any kind of studs or rings on the eye brows, chin, ears, nose etc.
- 17 Students are not allowed to wear low waist trousers or skirts or narrow bottom trousers. No bracelets, fancy pendants or amulets are to be worn by the students.



## MESS RULES FOR HOSTELLERS



- ☞ Mess menu will be designed by the hostel management committee normally on term basis, in consultation with mess manager and approval of the Principal. The menu shall be displayed in the dining hall of the hostel.
- ☞ The students should strictly observe the prescribed mess timings. Late or early food/breakfast will be served only in exceptional cases, with prior consent of the mess manager.
- ☞ On request from sick students, separate food will be prepared in mess and will be served in his/her room, if so required.
- ☞ Wastage of food in the mess must be avoided.
- ☞ Mess utensils are not to be taken out of the dining hall.
- ☞ Mess is operated with limited staff and during peak hours, it is observed that it becomes difficult to cater to the demands of all the students dining at a time. The students should, therefore, wait patiently for their turn to be served. Mess manager will take care to serve the students effectively during peak hours.





# FEES DEPOSIT AND ADVANCES

1. Fees must be deposited within the stipulated period.
2. Payment of fee and other dues should be made only to the school office.
3. Except for the routine payments and charges notified by the Principal, no additional payment should be made without a circular from the Principal. For any deposit contrary to this, school will not be responsible.
4. No cash is given to the students for the purchase of stationery or other items from school canteen or tuck shop or from anywhere outside. Cash can be given to the Hostel accountant. Written record has to be maintained.

# HOSTEL RULE FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- 1 Parents/guardians are not permitted to meet the boarders, without the permission of the Hostel Wardens. They will be allowed to meet the students only on prescribed days (Sunday). During school hours, parents/guardians are not allowed to visit their wards.
- 2 Due to security reasons, only parents/ guardians whose photographs are kept in the authorized register at the hostel are permitted to visit the students and take them on long weekends. Therefore parents are requested to hand over their photographs, their details and the authorised guardians phone numbers and photograph to the school office.
- 3 If during the course of a session a student needs to go home, he/she must obtain permission from the Coordinator & a class teacher in the form of a Leave Request and provide a written request sent by the concerned parents to the administrator, giving the valid reason and documents. In this regard, the school's leave policy will be observed.
- 4 No permissions will be granted to any student living in hostel for spending night out on weekends unless the parent themselves are available in the town and the student is staying with them.
- 5 Parents are advised not to contact the students during mandatory study hours.
- 6 Any application for attending marriages, functions or any other events during the school term will not be entertained, unless it pertains to the parents or siblings. Written permission in this regard must be obtained in time. No messages over the telephone and WhatsApp will be accepted in this regard.
- 7 Parents should not supply medicines to the students, unless, specially advised by the family doctor. These must be handed over to the house sister/brother along with instruction/prescription regarding its administration. Such medicines are to be administered entirely at the cost and responsibility of the parents.
- 8 Children will not be allowed to go with the drivers unless authorisation letter with photograph is sent by the parents.
- 9 On school holidays (Summer Vacation, Winter Vacation, Durga puja etc) students are not allowed to remain in the hostel. Parents have to get the tickets done keeping the test/exams timings of the school in mind. No students will be allowed to leave early or extend the block holidays.
- 10 Parents desiring to send any item to their ward should either deliver the same to the Warden or his/her nominee personally. Nothing should be delivered to the boarder directly.
- 11 Parents are requested not to confirm leave from students over phone. Parents should confirm over phone with warden then only plan to come to take the child.
- 12 Students are allowed to talk to the parents from Landline on fix days only on registered numbers. No students are allowed to carry the mobile phone. Video Calls are only allowed on the Child's Birthday/ Parent's birthday/Sibling Birthday.



## APPRECIATING YOUR TALENT, INSTILLING STRONGER SPIRIT: SCHOOL CLUBS

A regular conventional reading and learning is monotonous at times. DPS Durgapur provides the students with an open-ended learning that acknowledges the need of multiple fun and interesting activities incorporated into the visions of broader system of education. The clubs and the wide range of activities, keep the students engaged in various creative tasks that help them to rediscover their innate abilities in different ways. The clubs of the school are:

**Book Club:** This club is just perfect for voracious readers with opportunities to indulge in a multitude of activities like Wall Magazine, Literary Quiz, Book Jacket Designing, Slogan Writing.

**No-fire Cookery Club:** The club teaches the spirit of teamwork, culinary skills, to create awareness about the nutritional value of food, the necessity of healthy eating and encourages students to stay away from junk food.

**Chess Club:** A club that encourages to play the 'Sport for All' and gives children intellectual capital and transferable skills such as focus, discipline, concentration, spatial awareness and strategic thinking.
